The Department for Effective Public Management / Secretariat of Hemispheric Affairs of the Organization of American States (OAS), greets the Permanent Missions of the OAS and is pleased to inform that the OAS Diploma: Governance, Management and Public Leadership in the Inter-American System is open for registration.

The diploma is directed to public officials, political authorities, social leaders, citizens with public advocacy, academics and communication professionals. It offers tools to strengthen leadership skills and innovation capacities in public management in the current context with a regional vision and a transversal thematic perspective that addresses the challenges in democracy, human rights, multidimensional security and integral development.

To obtain the certification of the OAS Diploma, you must take 3 virtual trainings and a one week training in Washington, D.C. Virtual courses are offered throughout the year and participants will have until April 2020 to complete their courses. Likewise, the first on-site meeting will be offered at the OAS headquarters in Washington, DC, from March 4 to 8, 2019. Officials who have taken virtual courses with the OAS during 2016, 2017 and 2018 can validate their courses for the Diploma.

For further details, we include the call for the Diploma and we thank the good efforts of the Permanent Missions to support us with the promotion and distribution of this information to share with their capitals, in order to continue offering our support to the governments in the improvement of public management.
